in an academy.



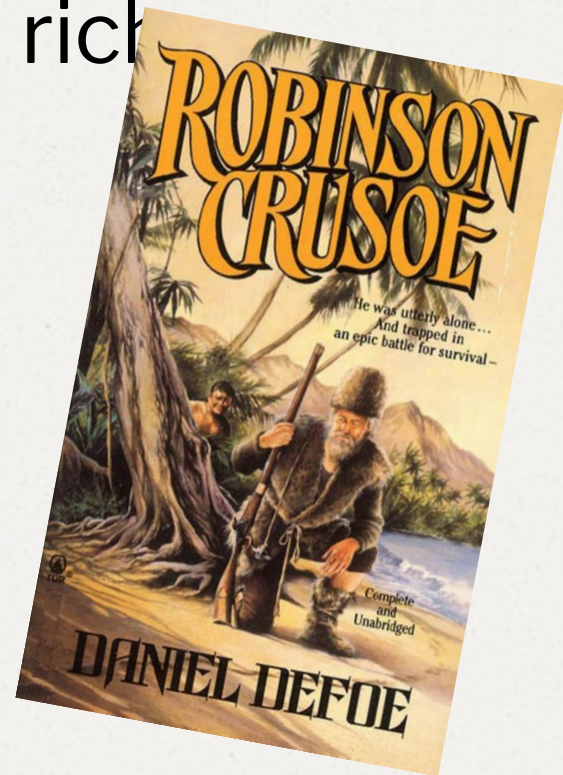
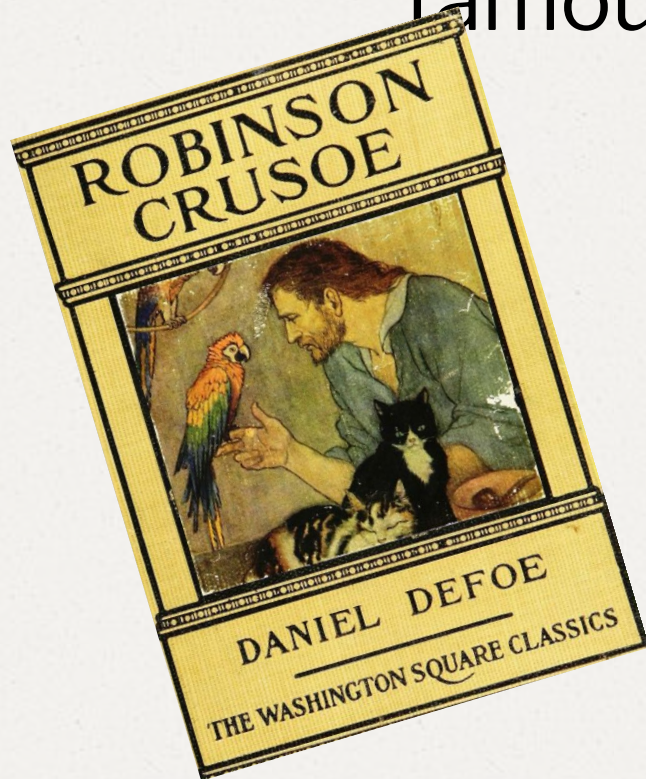
When he was 23 years old

famous and rich




He loved his family (his wife and his daughters), but he didn't want them to see him and he concealed his hiding place.




Last two years he lived in poverty and quite alone. He died in 1731.
