



FUTURE TENSE: WILL + VERB

Structure and functions

Future Tense: Will → Form

Affirmative: I will travel to Madrid in October.

Interrogative : Will you travel by bus?

Negative : I will not travel - won't

Will you travel by train or by bus?

I won't travel by bus I will probably travel by train



Future Tense: Uses of Will

- 1- Instant decisions: Ok, I'll see you on Friday
- 2- Predictions based in what we think: It will rain in the evening



- 3- Promises and offers: Don't worry, I'll go and buy some food for you

WILL



➤ I left the door open. I **will** close it right now.

(In the restaurant)



W :What would you like to drink?

➤ I **will** have a cup of coffee, please.



Did you call Sue?

No, I forgot it.

I **will** call her tonight

Don't worry. I **will** help you with your homework.



I **will** love you forever.



You **will** be rich
