Structure and functions


Future Tense: Will→ Form

Affirmative: I will travel to Madrid in October_

Interrogative: Will you travel by bus?

Negative: I will not travel - won't

Will you travel by train or by bus?
I won't travel by bus I will probably travel by train



Future Tense: Uses of Will

1- Instant decisions: Ok, I'll see you on Friday

2- Predictions based in what we think: It will

rain in the evening






