

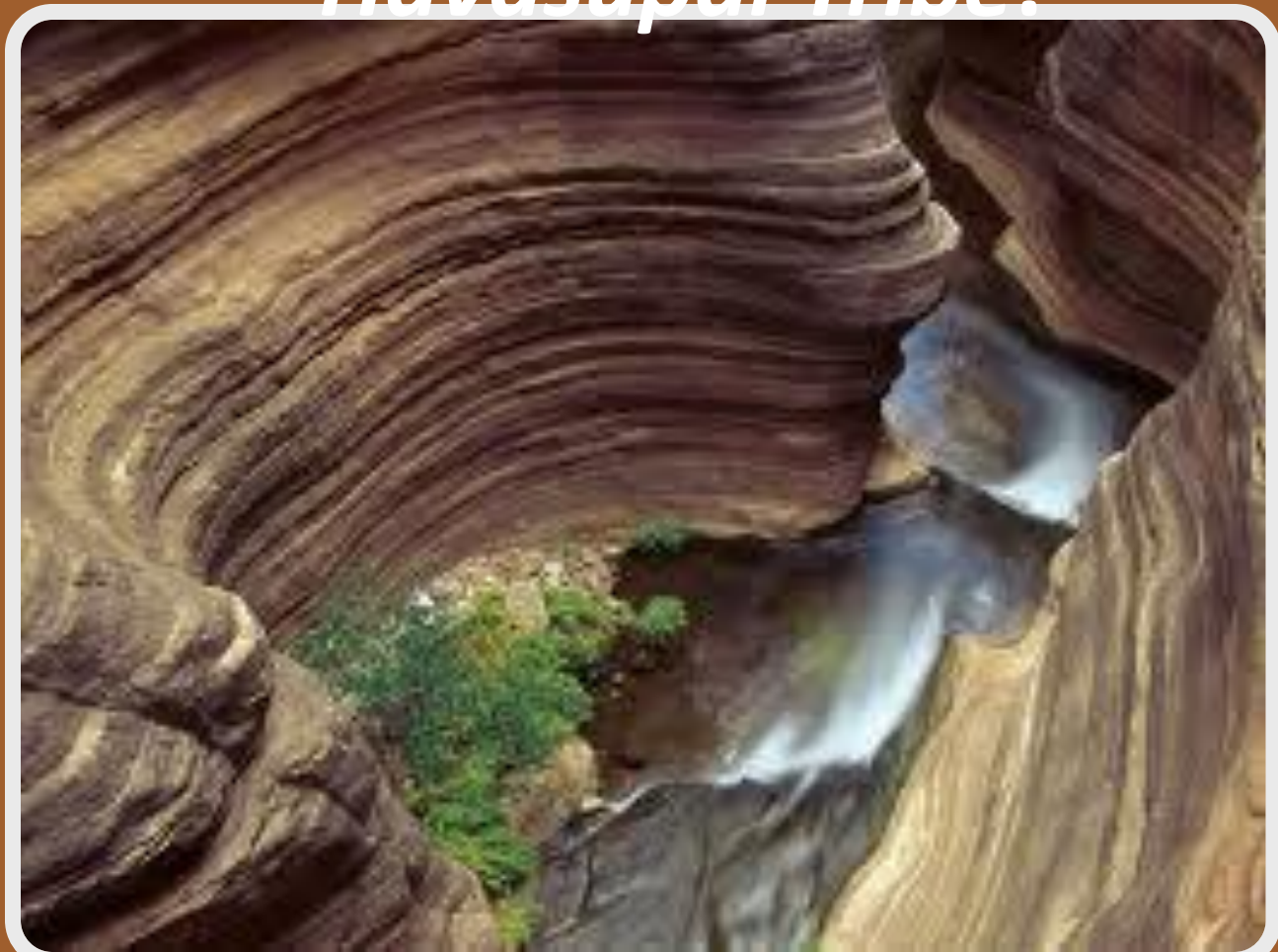


**GRAND  
CANYON**




**The Grand Canyon (Hopi: Ongtupqa; Yavapai: Wi:ka'i:la) is a steep-sided canyon carved by the Colorado River in the United States in the state of Arizona.**

It is contained within and managed by *Grand Canyon National Park*, the *Hualapai Tribal Nation*, and the *Havasupai Tribe*.



The Grand Canyon is 277 miles (446 km) long, up to 18 miles (29 km) wide and attains a depth of over a mile (6,000 feet / 1,800 metres).

***THE WIDE OF THE PLATEAU IS FROM EIGHT TO TWENTY-FIVE KILOMETRES. NEAR THE BOTTOM - LESS, THAN ONE KM. WITHIN THE LIMITS THE CANYÓN, RIVER COLORADO IS FALL AT THE SPEED OF 25 KM/HOUR. THE SURFACE OF THE PLATEAU, WHICH CUTS THROUGH THE CANYÓN, LOCATED AT AN ALTITUDE OF 1525 TO 2745 M ABOVE SEA LEVEL.***
