- The HTS provides the applicable tariff rates and statistical categories for all merchandise imported into states.
- It is based on the **International Harmonized System**.

International Harmonized System



The **Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System** generally referred to as "**Harmonized System**" or simply "**HS**" is a multipurpose international product nomenclature developed by the **World Customs Organization (WCO)**.

International Harmonized System



- **5,000 commodity groups**
- **a six digit code**
- **200 countries**
- **98 %**

The Harmonized Tariff Schedule **of the United States** (HTSUS) was enacted by **Congress** and made effective **on January 1, 1989**, replacing the former Tariff Schedules of the United States.
