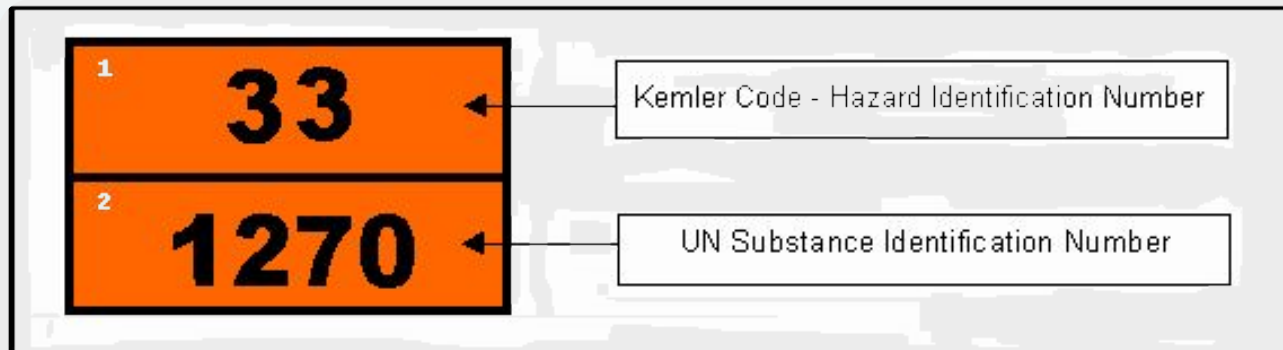




# ***HAZARD AND CARGO SYMBOLS***

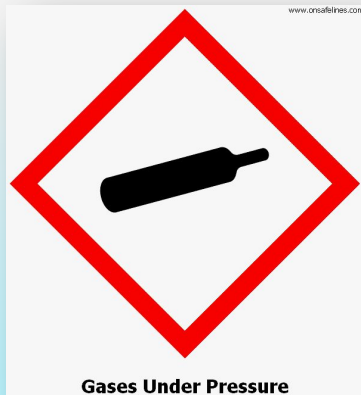
- Dangerous goods safety marks used for hazard identification of materials and vehicles during transportation.

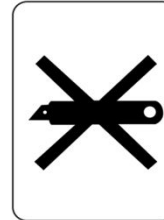
# Cargo symbols

<b>Sling here</b>	 A vertical chain of three links, representing a sling.
<b>Use no hooks</b>	 A hook symbol with a large 'X' over it, indicating that hooks should not be used.
<b>Temperature limitations</b>	 A thermometer symbol with a diagonal line through it, indicating temperature limitations.
<b>Do not use forklift truck here</b>	 A forklift truck symbol with a large 'X' over it, indicating that forklift trucks should not be used.

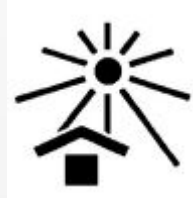



