Homeless animals

- Homeless animals — the pets who don't have owners, most often — vagrant dogs and homeless cats.
- The main form of work with neglected possessory and homeless animals in the western countries, in particular, with dogs — is irrevocable catching (that is withdrawal from an urban environment without the subsequent return of animals to the place of catching) and the room of the caught animals in shelters.



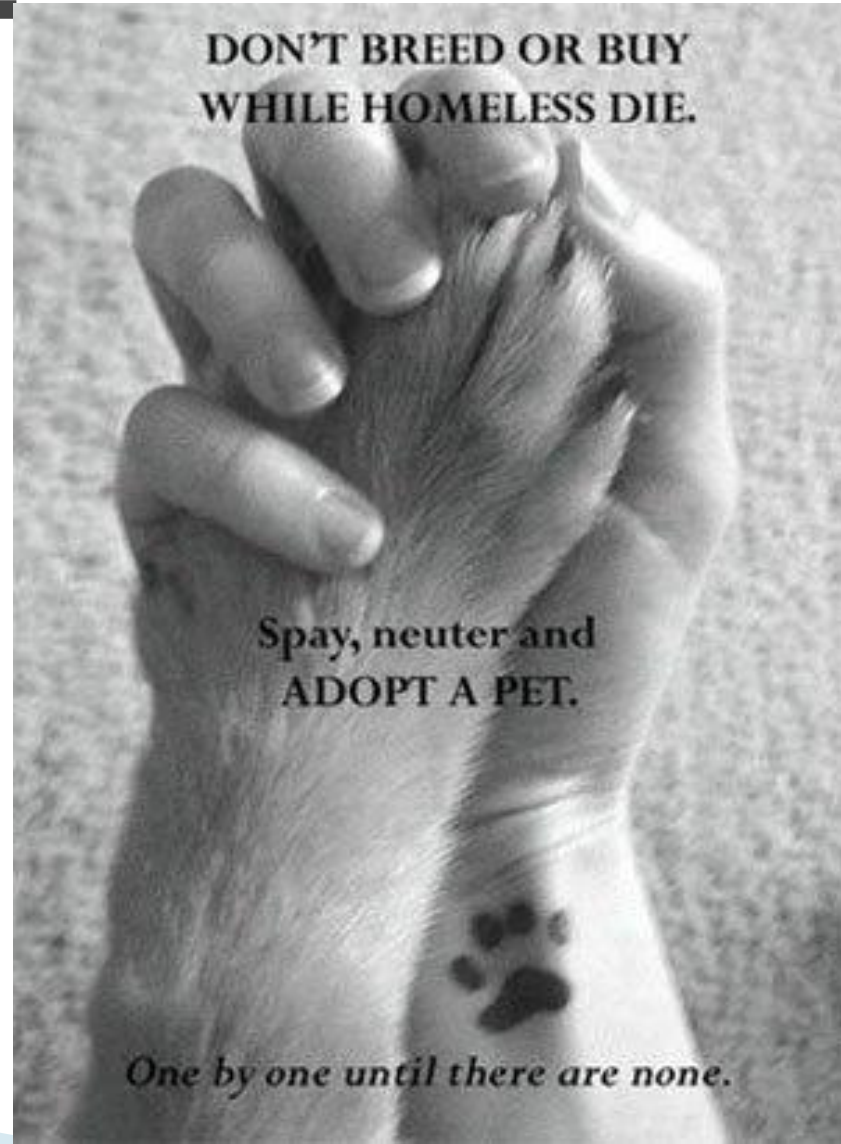
Distinguish two main types of an origin of homeless animals:

- 1. the animals who were born on the street, and never being the possessory;
- 2. the animals who once had the owner, but subsequently on the street owing to any reasons, such as:
 - unintentional loss of an animal;
 - intended refusal of the owner of the rights to an animal and from occupation by its perepristroystvo, accompanied by a vypuskaniye of an animal in free dwelling (that is, ejection of an animal);
 - death of the owner and subsequent ejection of an animal by successors.



The main methods of regulation of number of homeless animals treat:

- ❑ Sterilization of animals
- ❑ Catching of animals with the subsequent killing or the placement to nurseries
- ❑ Control over possession of pets.



Reasons

- At the moment, Russia has thousands of stray dogs and cats, but this figure is arbitrary. There is no publicly available statistics. Stray dogs and cats, no one believed there and clear laws on the regulation of the problem of homeless animals. In any case, the number of cats and dogs roaming the streets of Russia hundreds of times higher than the number of shelters for stray animals.



Decision

- Homeless animals shelter — a place of the maintenance of the homeless lost or thrown animals, mainly dogs and cats. Shelters are one of key components of protection of animals and carry out four main functions: the operational help and care of an animal, including relief of sufferings by means of the veterinary help; long-term care of the animal who hasn't found immediately old or new owner; efforts on reunion of the lost animal with his former owner; search of a new habitat or the new owner for a homeless animal.
