How to introduce yourself

Informal

Hi! I am ...

Hello! My name is ...

Formal

Hello! Let me introduce myself. My name is ...

Good morning / afternoon / evening.

Allow me to introduce myself. My name is ...

After introduction

Informal

Hi! Nice to meet you. – Nice to meet you too.

Hello! I am glad to meet you. –
Lovely to meet you too.

Formal

How do you do. – How do you do.

It's a pleasure to meet you. –
I am very pleased to meet you too.

How to introduce someone else

Informal

This is my friend ...

Formal

May I introduce my colleague ...

Allow me to introduce my colleague...

I would like you to meet my colleague...

How to greet someone you know

Informal

Hi! How are you? – Fine, thanks and you?

Hello! How are you doing? –
Great, thanks! How about you?

Formal

Good morning! How are you today? –
I am very well, thank you. And you?

Hello! It's nice to see you again. – And you.

How to say goodbye

Informal

I must go! Catch you later. – Ok, see you later. Bye.

I will be off now. Speak to you later. – Sure. Take care.

Formal

Goodbye. It's has been a pleasure meeting you. –
The pleasure is mine. I hope to see you again soon.

I must be on my way. It was nice seeing you again. –
Likewise. Look forward to see you again soon.
