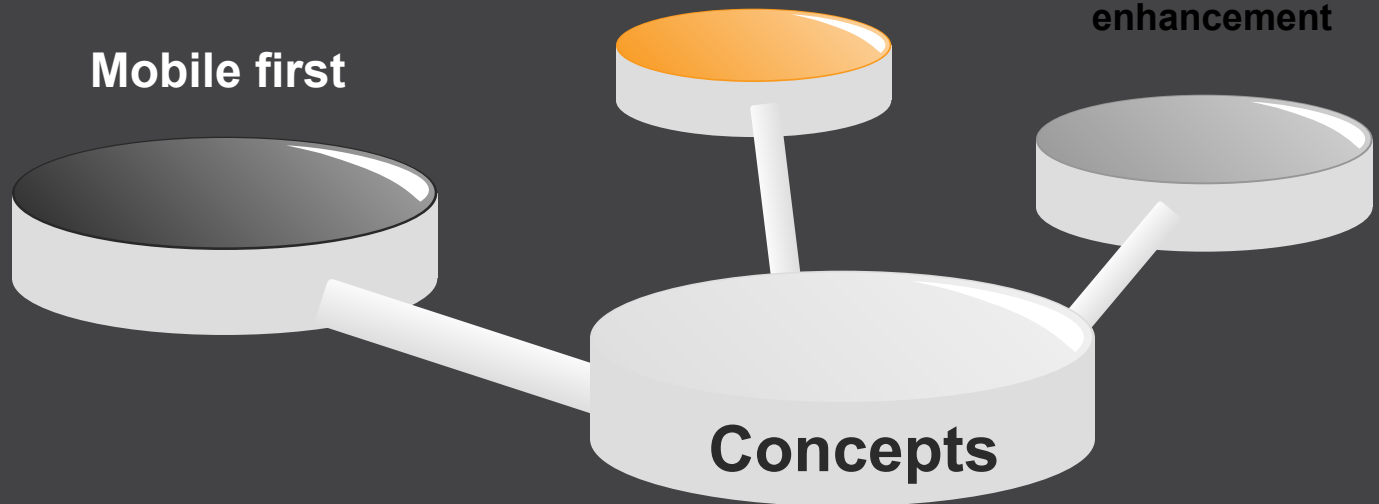

height	length	yes	height of the rendering surface
monochrome	integer	yes	number of bits per pixel in a monochrome frame buffer
orientation	landscape/portrait	no	Specifies the whether the display is in landscape mode or portrait mode
resolution	resolution ("dpi" or "dpcm")	yes	1 Dots per inch = 0.3937008 Dots per cm
width	length	yes	width of the rendering surface
