## House Napoleon

- History of the island
- Holy Island. Helena was discovered by Portuguese navigator Juan da Nova while traveling home from India May 21, 1502 on St. Helena. In 1613 the Portuguese drowned here Dutch ship "VitteLiuv" with a cargo of gold and 1311diamond .V island of St. Helena in 1815 became a place of exile of Napoleon Bonaparte, who died there in 1821 at his home in Longwood.
