Programming	 Writing code for computer software
Designing	 Computers, web pages, software, multimedia



Activities of IT Workers

Analyzing

 Modifying computer systems to improve production and workflow; expanding systems

Networking

 Connecting two or more computers together for communication purposes

Managing

 Monitoring and controlling computer systems



Careers in IT

Computer Engineer

Involves the understanding and design of computers and computational processes

Computer Operator

• Responsible for monitoring and controlling computer systems in a company or organization

Systems Administrator

• Maintains and operates a computer system or network for a company or other organization

 Writes codes for computer software Software Designer

 Designs, creates, and maintains software

Systems Analyst

 Programmer who designs and manages the development of business applications on the computer
