Johann Wolfgang von Goethe was born in Frankfurt am Main(Germany) in 1749



Mother, Catharina Elisabeth Goethe, nee Tekstor. His father, Johann Caspar Goethe, was the imperial adviser who was the lawyer.



In 1775 Goethe was invited, as the author of "Young Werther's suffering", to Karl Augustus, the duke of Saksen-Weimar-Eyzenakh.





Goethe married on Christian Vulpius in 1806
