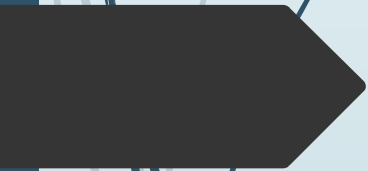

**I didn't want** to go to the cinema **yesterday**, because I **had already seen** the film. — Я не хотела вчера идти в кино, потому что уже видела это фильм.

Т.е. я видела этот фильм раньше, до вчерашнего дня.



I **have** already **eaten** apples.

**Do** you go to this school?

**Does** she have a dog?

I **had** already **eaten** apples when he **began** to eat plums.

**Did** you go to this school?

**Did** she have a dog?

## PRESENT PERFECT

- Действие началось в прошлом и продолжается до сих пор:

I have lived in this city for six months.

- Действие произошло в прошлом:

I have been to Japan twice.

My mother **has just gone** to the store.

Janet **has lived** abroad for five years.

I **haven't seen** the new movie yet.

**Have** you **finished** your homework?

## PAST PERFECT

Действие случилось до  
определенного времени в  
прошлом:

- **By 5 o'clock** – к пяти часам
- By Saturday** – к субботе
- By that time** – к тому времени

**By the end of the year he had learnt to speak French.** – К концу года он (уже) научился говорить по-французски.

**I had been to Japan twice by the time I was 10 years old.** – Я (уже) побывал в Японии дважды, когда мне было 10 лет.


- Предпрошедшее время

When we **arrived** at the party, Ann **had already gone home** – Когда мы приехали на вечеринку, Аня уже уехала домой

1. My husband ate breakfast at 6:00 AM

2. I woke up at 7:00 AM

When I woke up this morning, my husband **had already eaten breakfast.** – Когда я проснулась утром, мой муж уже позавтракал.

Continuous	+ to be (am, is, are) + <u>V+ing</u>	+ to be ( <b>was, were</b> ) + <u>V+ing</u> <b>was</b> (I, he, she, it) – ед. число <b>were</b> (you, we, they) – множ. число
Perfect	_ + to have (have, has) + <u>V+ed</u> <u>(III)</u>	_ + to have ( <b>had</b> ) + <u>V+ed (III)</u>
