Miliband and Balls knew UK's economy was due to 'fall off a cliff'... but kept it secret

ED MILIBAND and Ed Balls knew about the economic crash of 2008 a year before it happened - but kept it secret. It was occasionally revealed last night.

The Labour leader did not say in a exclusive new report that he both urged Prime Minister Gordon Brown to call a snap election in 2007 because 'the economy was about to fall off a cliff' and it was Labour's only hope of holding on to power.

Chancellor George Osborne said the revelation 'topped the crown' of Balls and Miliband, adding 'they were more interested in saving their own skins than saving the British economy'.

A BACKLASH against lifting border controls with Romania and Bulgaria appeared to be spreading in Europe last night when it emerged that even Germany wants to block the move.

The country's interior minister vowed to cut the German veto when European Union ministers discuss admitting the former Eastern Bloc nations this week.

Baroness Prichard warned the plans could spark a massive wave of benefit tourists and accused of sharing British concerns about the growing influx of migrants.

Speaking in a BBC interview yesterday, Mr Prichard said that the right of free movement drew all people in Europe the opportunity to go to another country to work or education, but it shouldn't be allowed to go to Germany or Great Britain just to get social security.

He added: 'That is the reason why we want to send people back, and that is what we have to explain in European law. There's no problem when people are coming to Germany for work.'

BBC3 faces questions over tabloid TV

MARK THOMPSON, the head of the BBC, is to be questioned by MPs over the "dubious" content of the corporation's channel for young adults after commissioning a string of programmes with explicit-ridden titles.

The latest offerings from BBC3 include F*** Off, I'm a Hairy Woman, F*** Off, I'm Gineer, and My Bis Breasts

Other shows to be broadcast on the digital channel later this year include a £200,000 documentary, The History of the C-Word, and a programme about the size of men's penises.

Critics believe that BBC3 has plunged to depths of sensationalism that were once the preserve of Channel 4 when it earned its then boss, Michael Grade, the newspaper columnist's sobriquet of "pornographer-in-chief".

The critics claim BBC3, which is aimed at the 16-34 age group and has an annual

meet the BBC's public service remit and is a waste of licence payers' money.

Thompson is due to give evidence to the Commons culture, media and sport select committee's ad hoc Easter as part of its inquiry into public service broadcasting.

John Whittingdale, the committee's chairman, said: 'Ever since it started, BBC3 has always seemed to me to comprise of somewhat dubious programmes.


