Cornus racemosa 'Geauge'



Gray Dogwood

- Host plant for spring azure butterfly
- Plentiful, nutritious berries for many birds
- Provides good nesting sites and cover for birds

Gray twig dogwood bears dome-shaped clusters of white flowers in late spring giving way to clusters of small white berries. The stems are licorice red which makes a distinct contrast. Leaves turn dusky purple-red in fall. This thicket-forming shrub is a good source of food, cover and nesting sites.

Allegheny Spurge

- Semi-evergreen groundcover that thrives in shade
- A great early supply of nectar.
- Fragrant bloom is effective and attractive

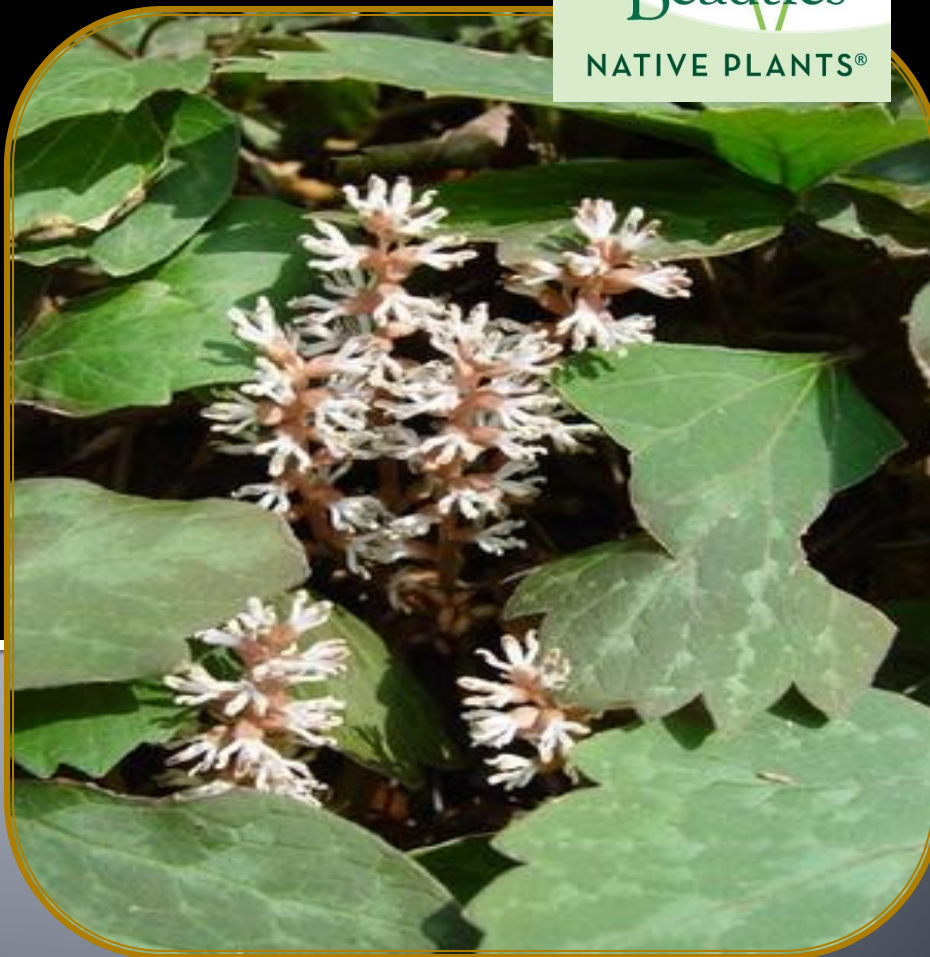
Bluish green leaves are slightly mottled and are held on upright stems that slowly spread on rhizomes to form sizeable colonies. Pinkish-white, fragrant flowers cover stem tops on 2 to 4" spikes in mid April attracting a host of early nectar seekers. Thrives in shade and provides great cover.

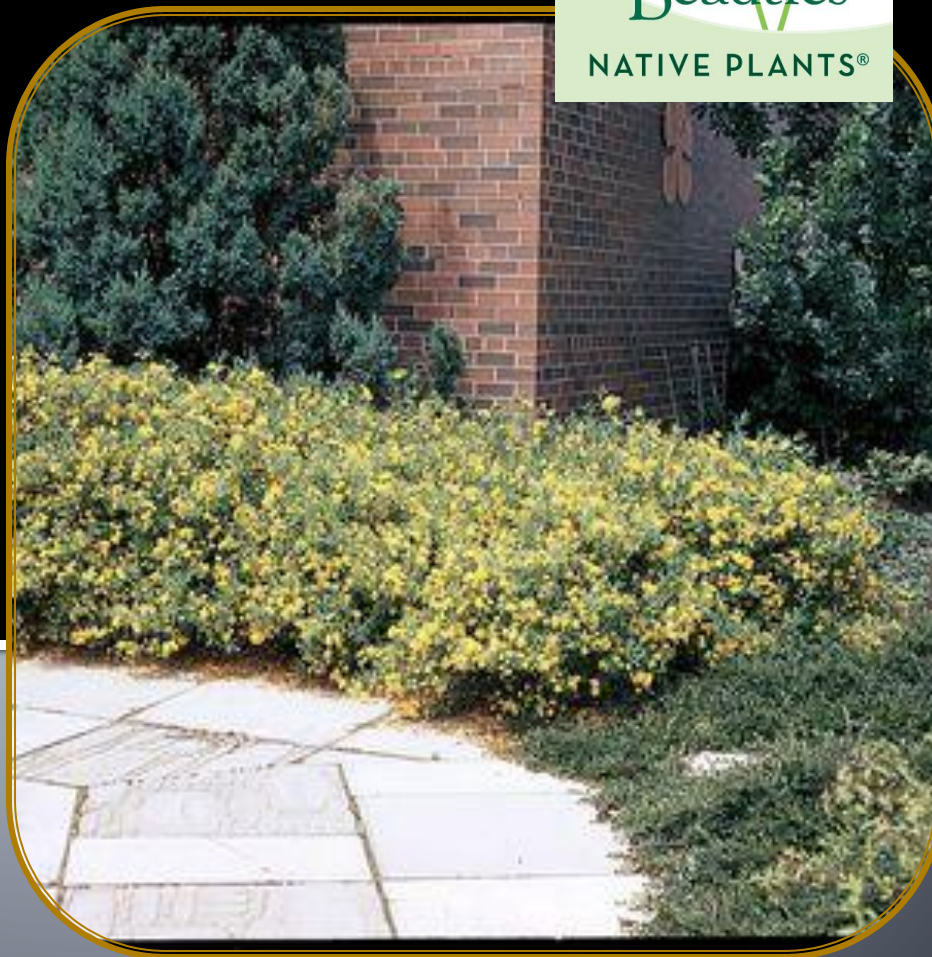


NEW PLANTS 2016

Hypericum kalmianum 'Gemo'

St. John's Wort

This selection is more tightly branched than the species and blooms longer as well. Butterflies and native bees are drawn in numbers to its large yellow flowers from July till September. Willow like foliage is unique looking, clean, pest free and adds subtle yet effective texture to the landscape.

Yucca filamentosa 'Excalibur'



Dwarf Adam's Needle

- Slightly smaller and more uniform than straight species
- Bluish tint to foliage
- White bell-shaped flowers early to midsummer reach up to 5 feet

This yucca has beautiful blue green foliage with numerous curly, white filaments for added texture. It has a neat, round habit, smaller than the straight species. The amazing flower stems reach 4-5' in height and it's a host plant for skippers. A tough as nails perennial for sunny, dry sites including dry slopes.

There are few roses as popular as those of deep crimson colouring – and none so difficult to breed. 'Heathcliff' is a beautiful addition to English Roses of this colour. It has large, fully double flowers of deep rosette shape. It is a healthy variety, with shiny, deep green leaves and rather upright growth. Its fragrance is most pleasing and rather unusual – basically Tea Rose with a mixture of Old Rose and just a hint of cedar wood

The colour is a deep crimson, with a certain softness that is reminiscent of some of the old red Gallica Roses. Plant in full sun in moist well-drained soil.

Rosa 'Port Sunlight'

DAVID AUSTIN® ROSES



This rose bears medium sized flowers of rich apricot colouring. They are of flat rosette shape and slightly quartered at the centre; the outer petals falling back a little and becoming paler. They have a rich Tea fragrance. The foliage and young stems are bronzy-red at first, becoming a fairly dark green. The growth is vigorous and rather upright, about 5 ft. in height by 3.5 ft. across, making it ideal for the back of a mixed border where it will compete well with other plants. It is very resistant to disease. All in all, a good, reliable variety.

It is named after the model village in the Wirral in the UK built by William Hesketh Lever, where they have a beautiful garden of English Roses.

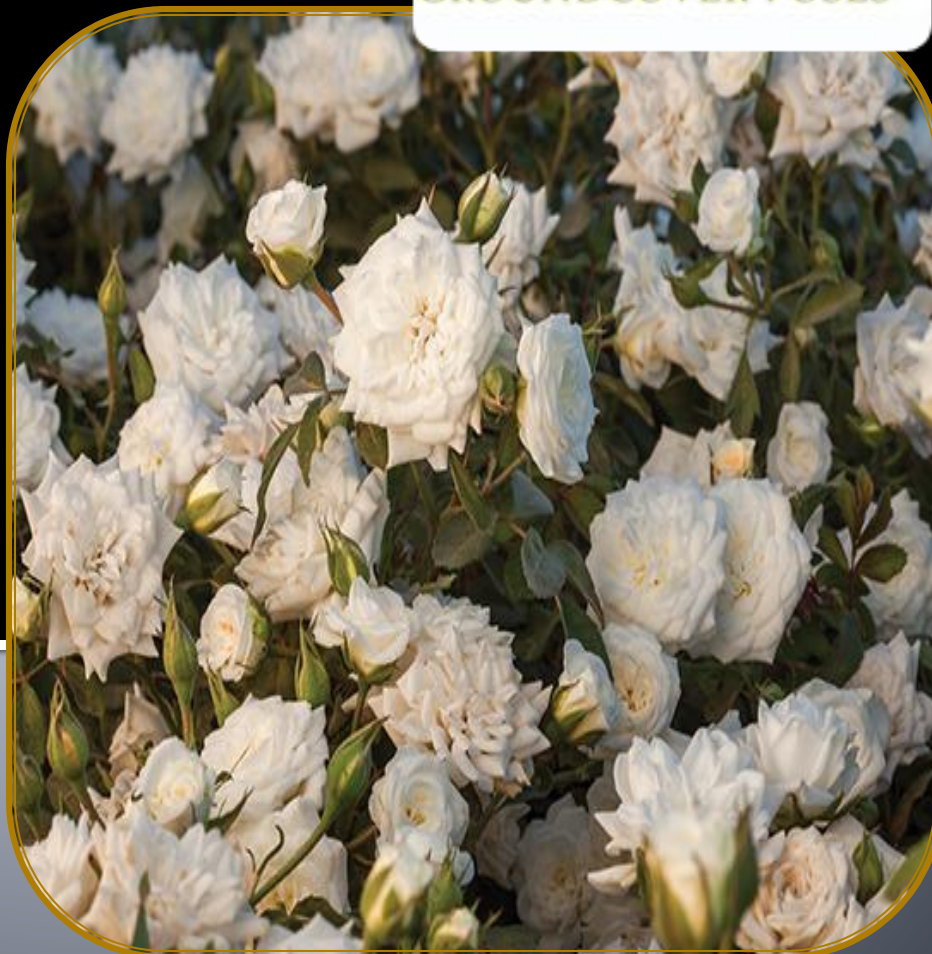

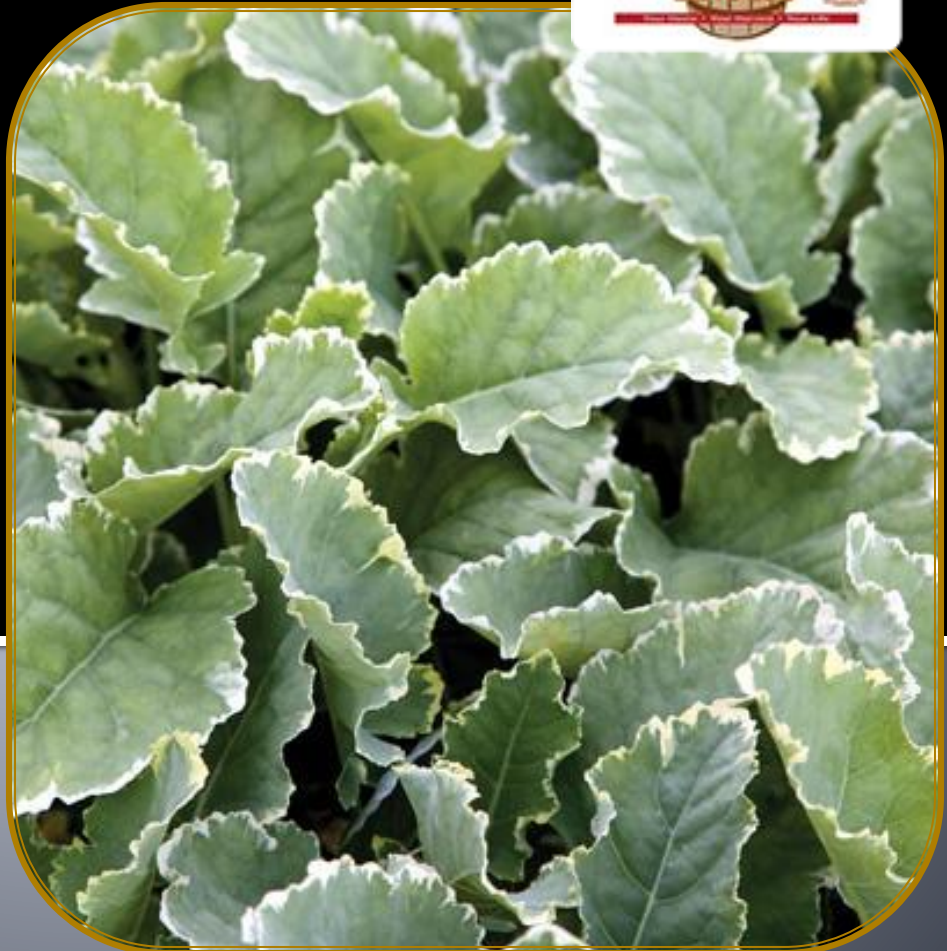

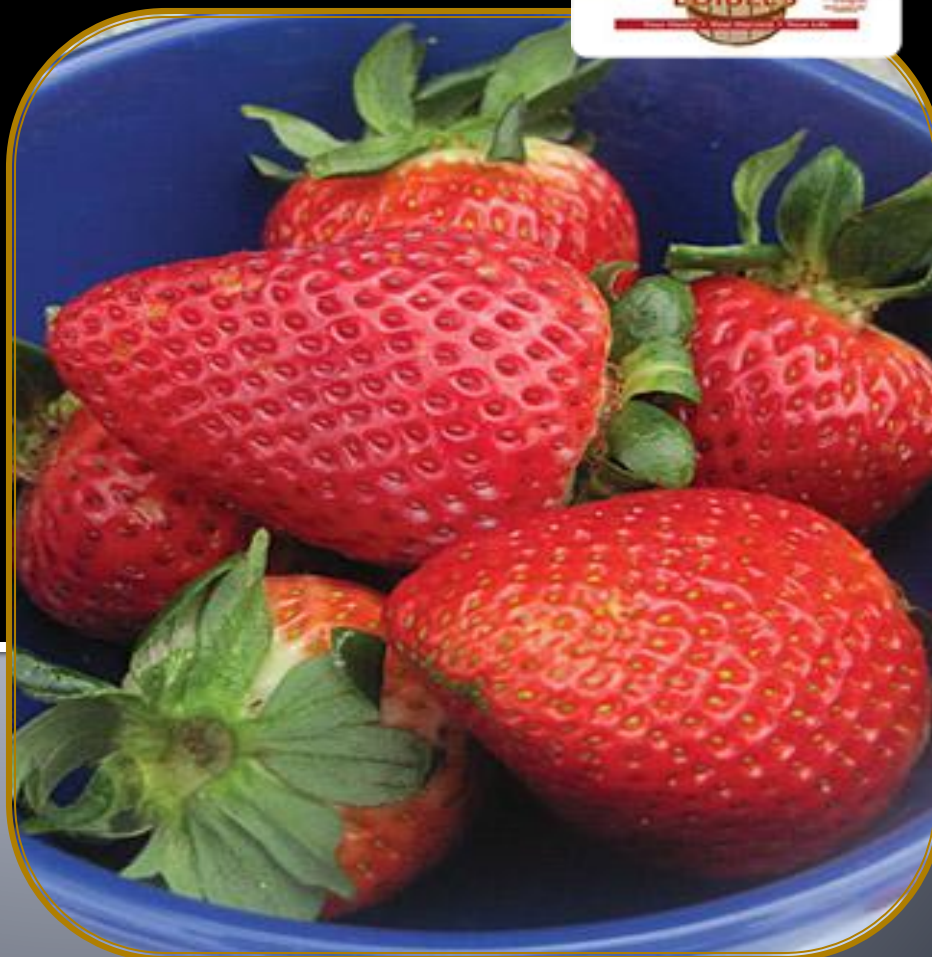

Thrives in partial shade and removed spent blooms or allow them to stay and reseed for a beautiful naturalizing effect.

Its very compact habit is a great choice for mixed containers, or let it spread ever so slowly in the landscape along pond and stream edges, rain gardens or perennial borders.
