**Цель урока:** развитие умения строить монологическое высказывание по заданной теме (описание дома/квартиры).

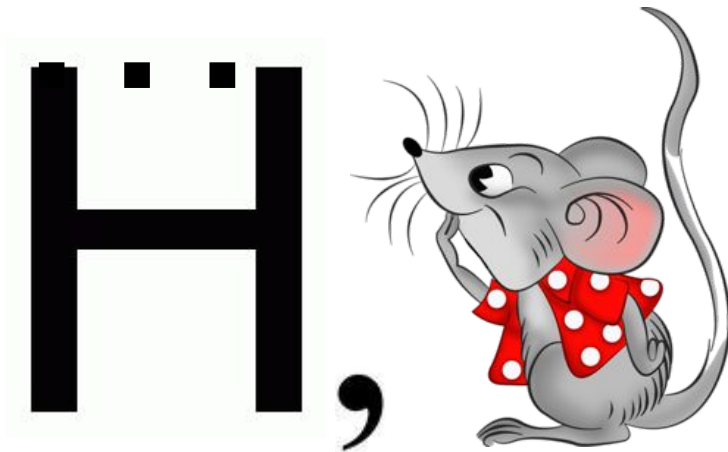
## **Задачи урока:**
