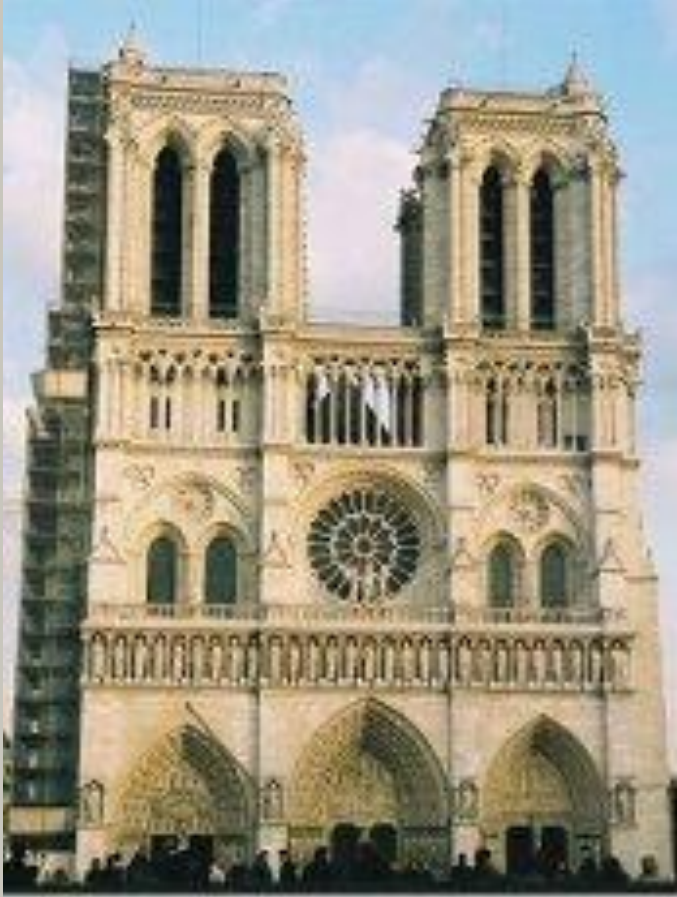
# Louvre
