

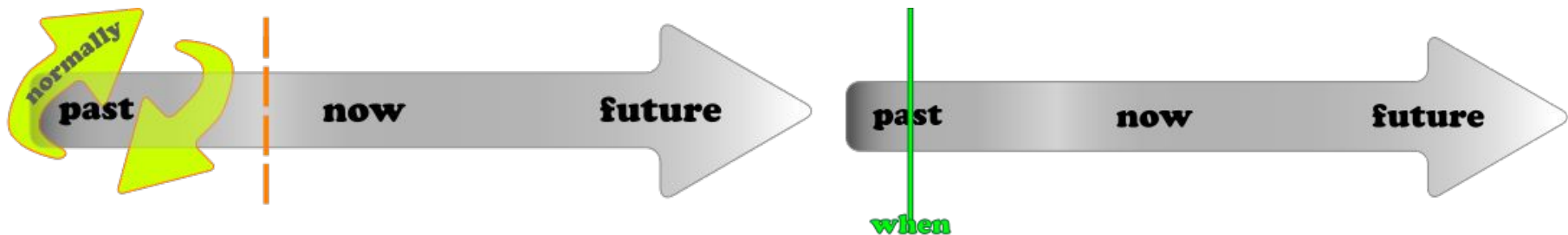

What's this?

- * Time Past Simple is used to refer to actions that occurred at a specific time in the past and the time of which has already expired.
- * For example: Yesterday I cleaned my shoes.



Verbs



Regular verbs

talk	ed
phone	d
arrive	d
play	ed
walk	ed
ask	ed



Irregular verbs

eat	ate
drink	drank
swim	swam
run	ran
see	saw
meet	met

Education Past Simple

Affirmative offer:

I played	We played
You played	You played
He / She / It played	They played

Interrogative sentences:

Did I play?	Did we play?
Did you play?	Did you play?
Did he / she / it play?	Did they play?

Negative sentences:

I did not play	We did not play
You did not play	You did not play
He / she / it did not play	They did not play

Time Past Simple is used

- ❖ An indication of the simple action in the past:
 - *The Titanic sank in 1912.*
 - I **saw** Jeremy in the bank.
- ❖ To transmit a sequence of actions that have occurred in the past, one after another:
 - I **heard** a strange sound, **looked back**, and **saw** a huge cat sitting on the table.
- ❖ Regular, repetitive actions in the past:
 - The old man often **visited** me
