If you disagree with something they say, don't be afraid to speak your mind!

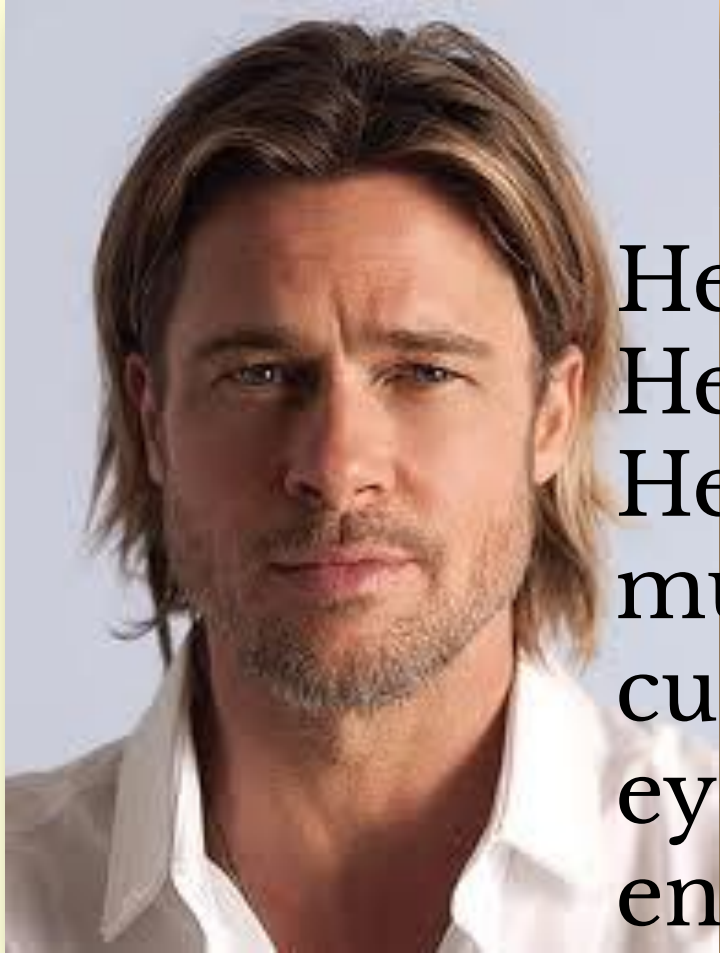
Will you turn that music down? It's driving me crazy!

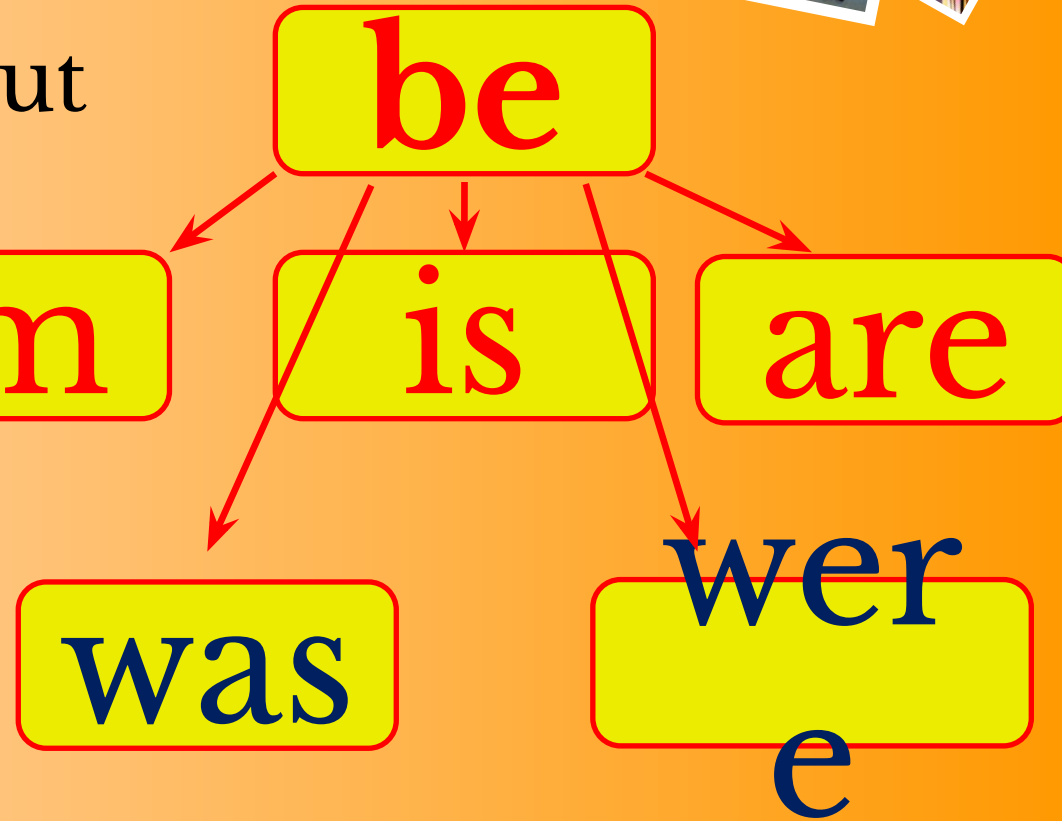
