

# The fight against plastic bags

- ▶ To combat pollution of the environment with plastic bags used different measures, and about 40 countries have banned or restriction on the sale and production of plastic bags



- ▶ The world's first free zone of plastic bags (plastic bag-free) has appeared in Australia in January 2004. It was Island Kangaroo.
- ▶ Singapore, Bangladesh, Taiwan: a complete ban on the use of plastic bags since 2003 because of the numerous cases of clogging sewer and river beds overlap, leading to flooding.
- ▶ Tanzania: the penalty for the manufacture, importation or sale of plastic bags is either \$ 2,000 or an year in prison. Import of plastic bags on Zanzibar is prohibited.
- ▶ England: in the autumn of 2004 in the UK first biodegradable bags for bread were launched on the market the world's.
- ▶ Finland: in supermarkets and vending machines used for receiving packets that are used as raw materials for processing and production of new plastic.

# Positive impact on environmental

- ▶ Eco-bags are made of different materials, using waste or secondary raw materials, an increase of 100% corresponds to the careful attitude to natural resources
- ▶ When disposing of eco-bags (which does not happen very often), stands out much less harmful substances than for recycling plastic bags
- ▶ Using multiple, eco-bags, thrown much less, thereby reducing environmental pollution. And most of them are made of natural fabrics, so that about any pollution in general there is no question

# Usefully for you



- ▶ Eco-bags are durable: they have strong handles, they stand a much greater weight than the normal package, as in the case of contamination easy to wash (one eco-bag will serve you for the same period in which will be used and thrown away hundreds of plastic bags);
- ▶ Eco-bags always win bright and stylish design, the most famous designers believe honorable duty to give birth to an original eco-friendly handbag.
