# The Imperial Academy of Arts

- Decree of Peter the 1<sup>st</sup> “about the academy, for studying languages and other sciences and noble arts” → emerging of the art department in the Academy of Sciences;

1757 – institution of “**Special three noblest Arts Academy**” by Elizaveta Petrovna (advised by Shuvalov);

- 1758 – the beginning of studies

*Three age groups:*

*6-9 years*

*9-12 years*

*12-15 years*

□ *16 years – becoming a student of academy;*

□ *The course lasted 9 years, the program included studying engravings, portraits, sculpture, architecture;*

□ *Graduated from the Academy were awarded the title of the artist, the ones who got a golden medal could go abroad free for improving skills.*

# History

- The first classes were conducted in Shuvalov`s palace on Sadovaya street



- 1764—88 - the erection of the main building on Vasilyevsky island



# The building of the Academy

## 1800 – “the century of academism”

- *Appearance of medal and restorative classes;*
- *The serfs were allowed to visit academy as “free-coming listeners”;*
  - *30<sup>th</sup> of August 1859– new charter.*
    - *Two departments*

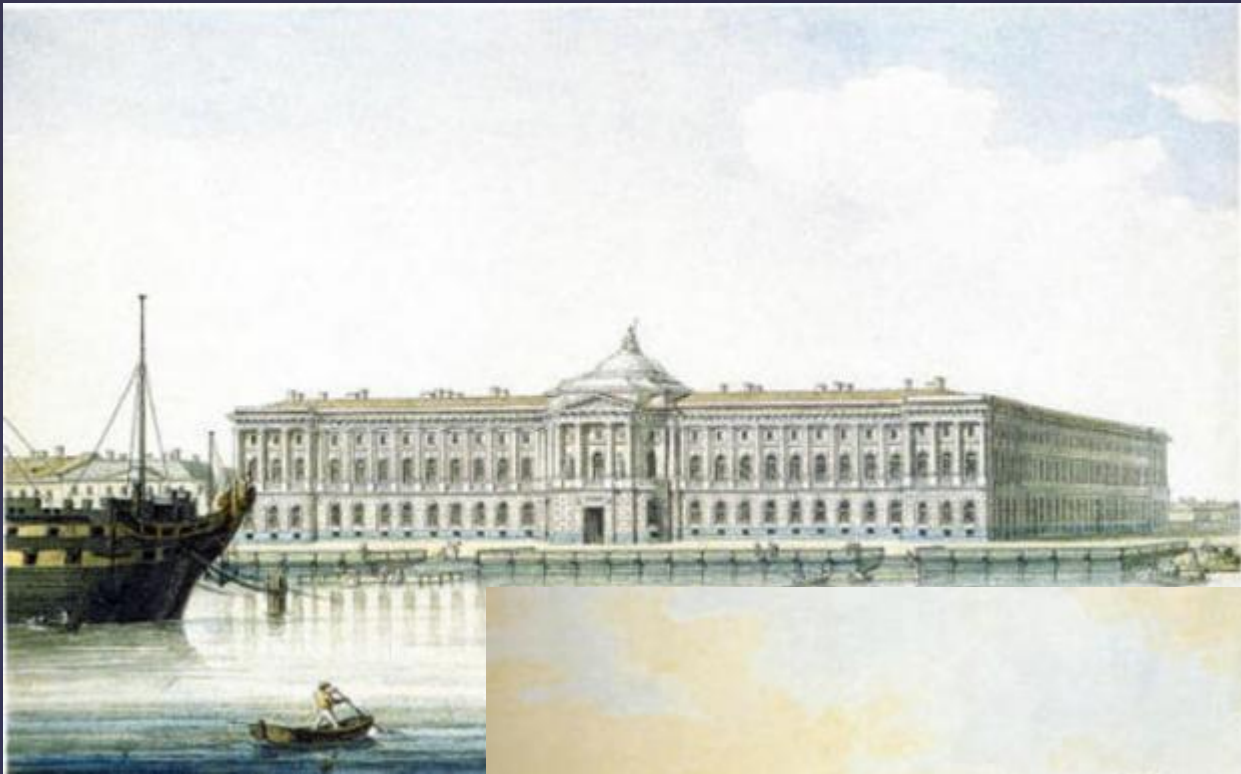

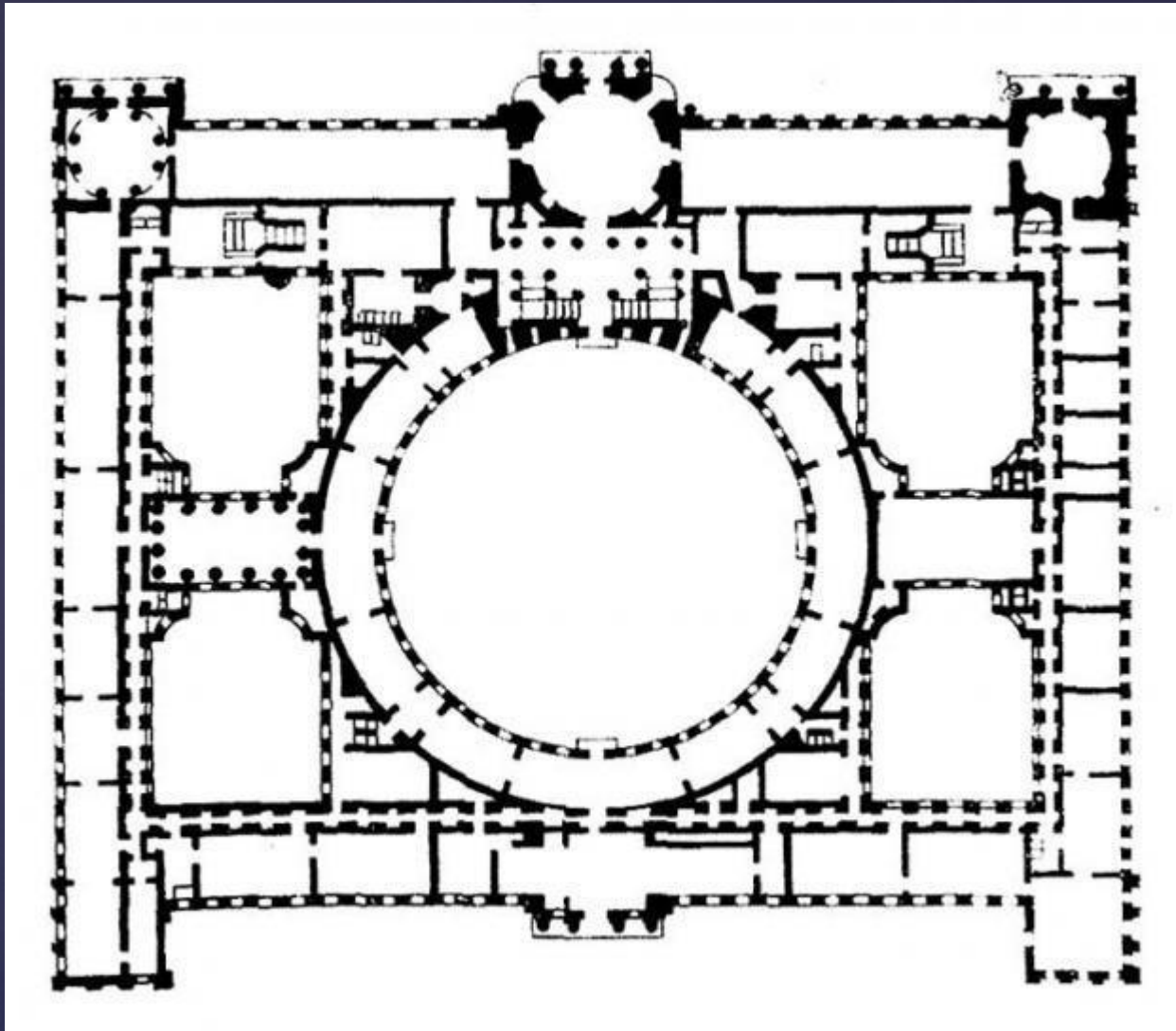
- *Introduced the teaching of mathematics, physics and chemistry;*
- **9<sup>th</sup> of november 1863** – “revolt of fourteen” – emergence of realistic style of painting;
- **The end of the XIX century** – opening of the Art museum;

# History

- ▣ **1917** – October revolution                      reorganization to PSRATW - Petrograd State Free Art-training workshops;
- ▣ **1932** – reorganization to Leningrad Institute of Painting, Sculpture and Architecture;
- ▣ **1944** – assignment the name of I.E.Repin;
- ▣ **1990s** – reorganization to St. Petersburg State Academic Institute of Painting, Sculpture and Architecture named after Ilya Repin.

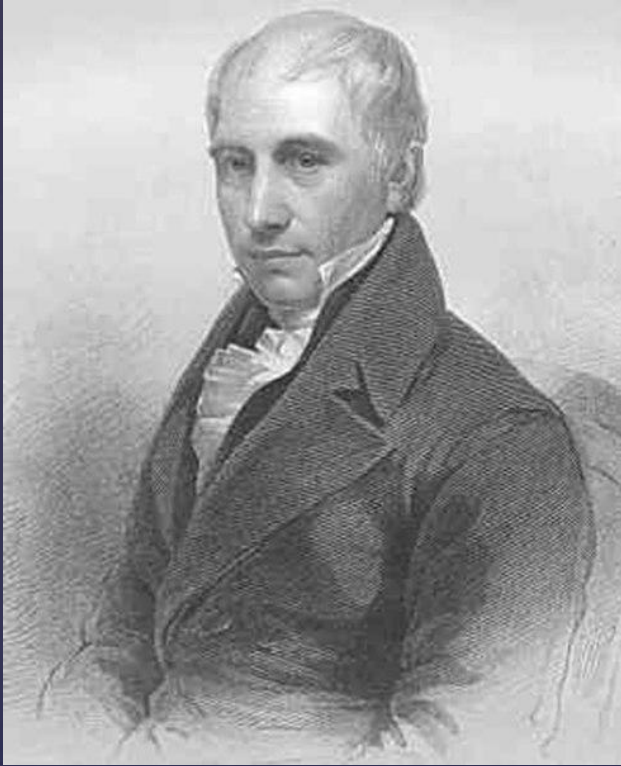

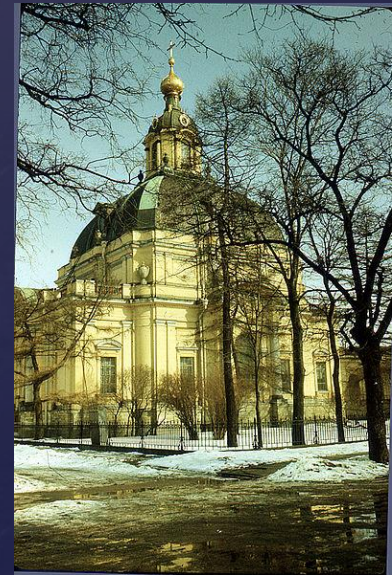

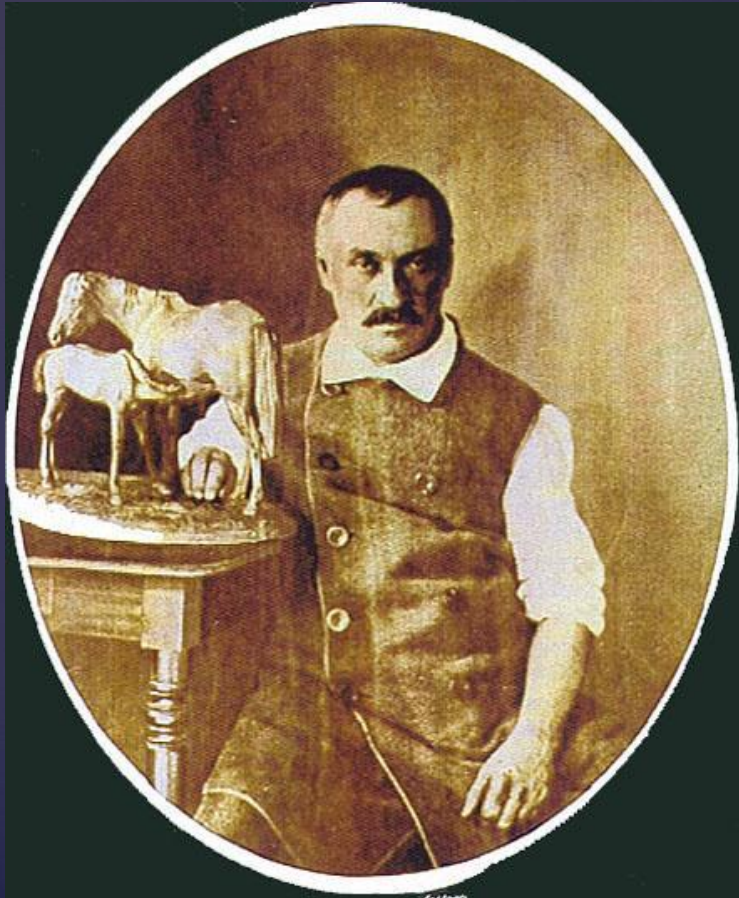

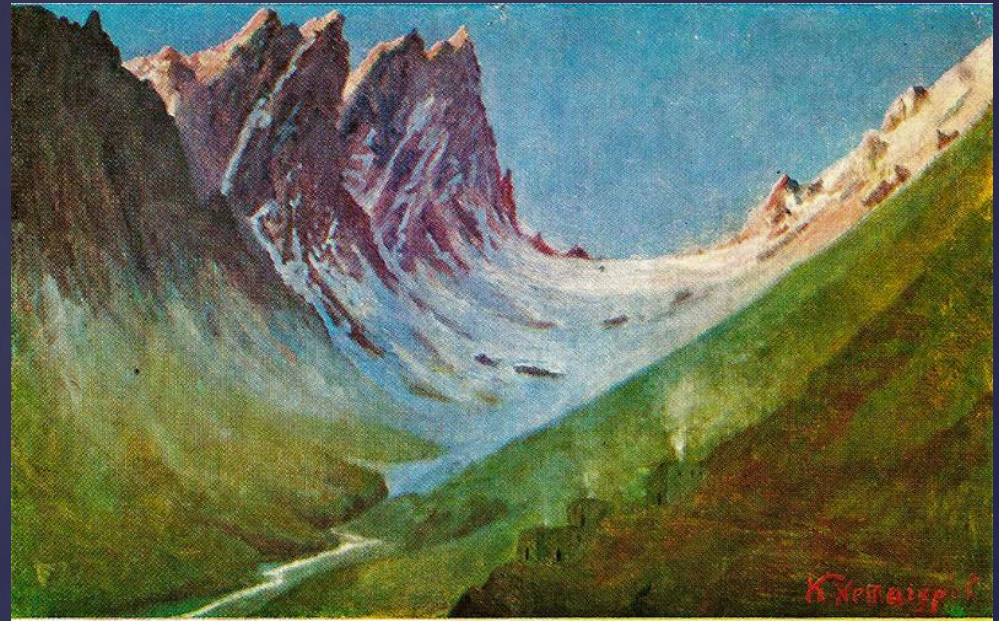
