# The Changing of the Guard

Also in London, there is another, not directly associated with the queen, but it is very attractive for tourists tradition - Ceremony of the Keys (Ceremony of the Keys). It has been 700 years in a row, every night chief jailer Tower of London, more commonly known as beefeater, doing a ritual door lock Tower. All gates must be locked at exactly 21 hours 53 minutes. Thereafter, regular trumpeter blows Tower and the ceremony ends with a retreat.



# Traditions and Culture in the life of Scotland.

Culture, customs and traditions of Scotland - this is what keeps them modern society. Everyone knows that tradition and a tribute to its roots for the Scots - everything. The first and most important thing for every Scot - it is his clan. Common ancestors of modern people in Scotland are combined into larger clans. Clans are still preserved as a tribute to tradition. Representatives of various clans rather easy to distinguish by coloring and various color combinations on a kilt.



Kilt - Scottish traditional costume , which occurred on a huge rug . In the ancient Scottish warriors plaid tossed over his shoulder , belting and fixing it . And there was a kilt . Sew from his tartan - traditional fabrics of different colors in a thin strip cell . Different colors, shades them cross each other at a certain angle tartan . There are many varieties of them , and they all come from different clans , and what they say are their distinguishing features . Such traditions of Scotland in English is often taught in universities.

It may be noted that in his time as a matter of everyday kilts and festive clothes were canceled and were even banned. But the ban did not last long, though this is more than enough time to Scots forgotten patterns and coloring materials. They had to recover from the drawings and records of different clans.

# New Year in Scotland.

- New Year traditions in Scotland also refer to old times. New Year is called Hogmanay. Both traditional vpuskanie is the new year. This tradition is symbolic, as it means the transition from the old man to a new, better life. Despite the fact that the standard of living in Scotland is quite high compared with other European countries, all people want to live better, so cross that border to enter the new year.

# Holidays.

- Halloween is celebrated on October 31.
