What is translation?

Translation is the replacement of a source text in a target text.

Source text or **source language** (ST or SL) is an original text or language.

Target text or **target language** (TT or TL) is a language into what text is translated.

What is translating?

Translating is the process of translation.

There are **3 rules** of translation:

- **You should keep the idea of the text**
- **You should keep the style and manner**
- **Translation should be**

There are 3 ways of translation:

- **Word-for-word translation**
- **Meaning-for-meaning translation**
- **Loan translation**
