most famous cities in the world. Oxford – the city in Great Britain, the capital of the County of Oxfordshire.

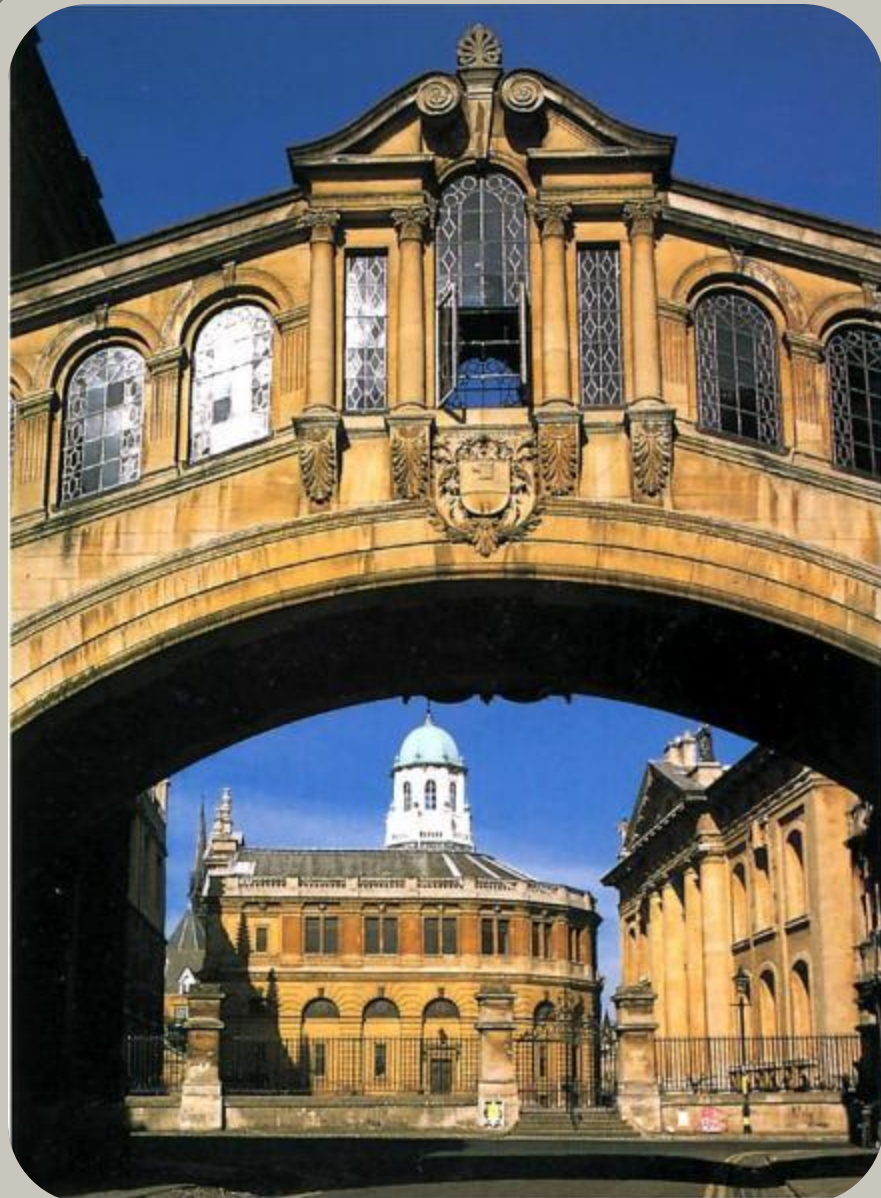


Oxford University. It also called a city of students, because over 12000 students live and study here in thirty-five colleges.

places for students and dons to visit. For example the Sheldonian Theater, which is used for concerts and university's ceremonies.

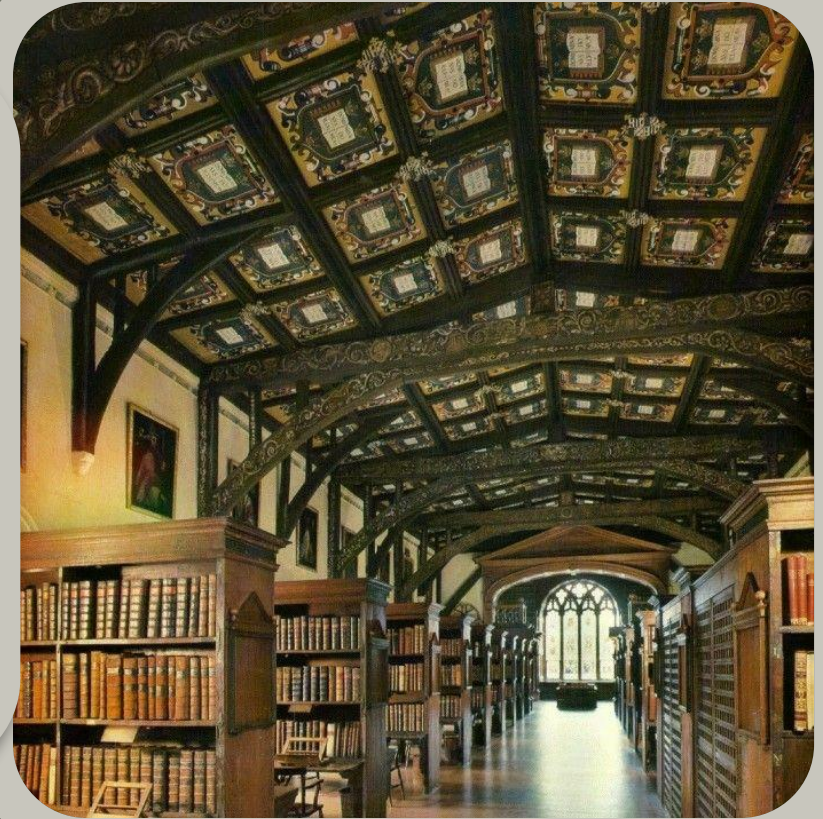
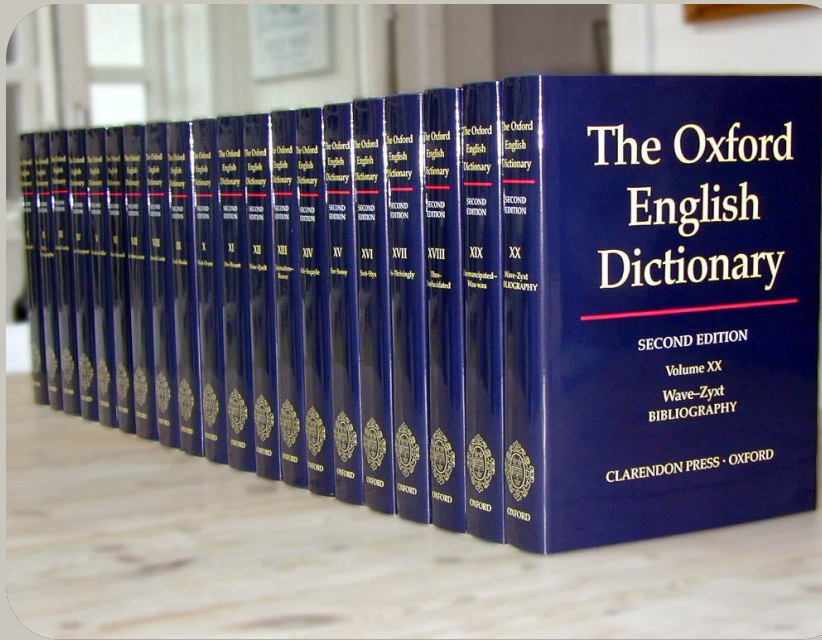
