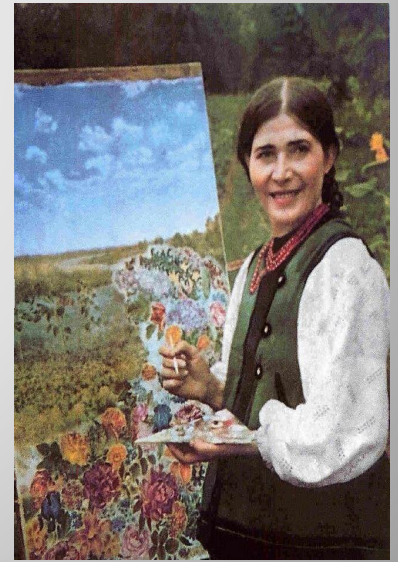
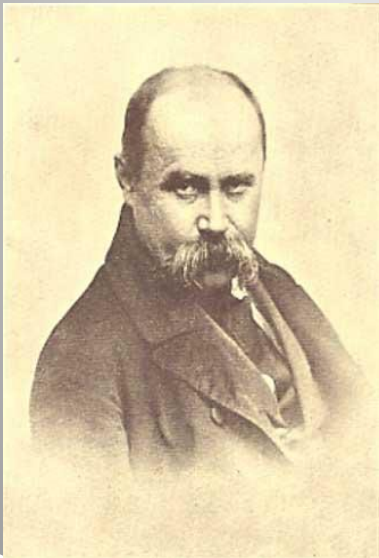
People in Ukraine

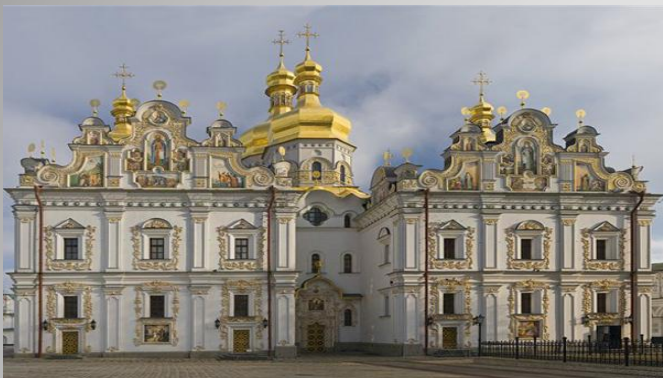

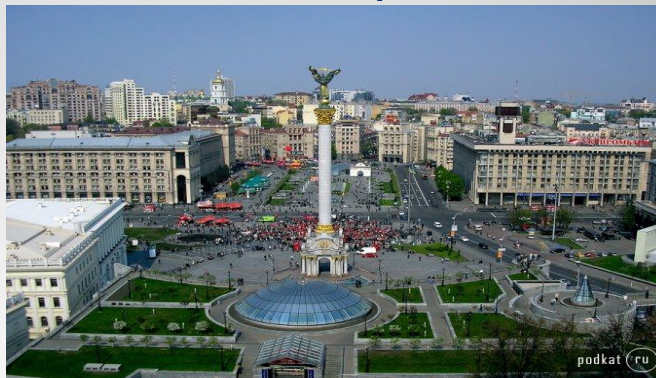

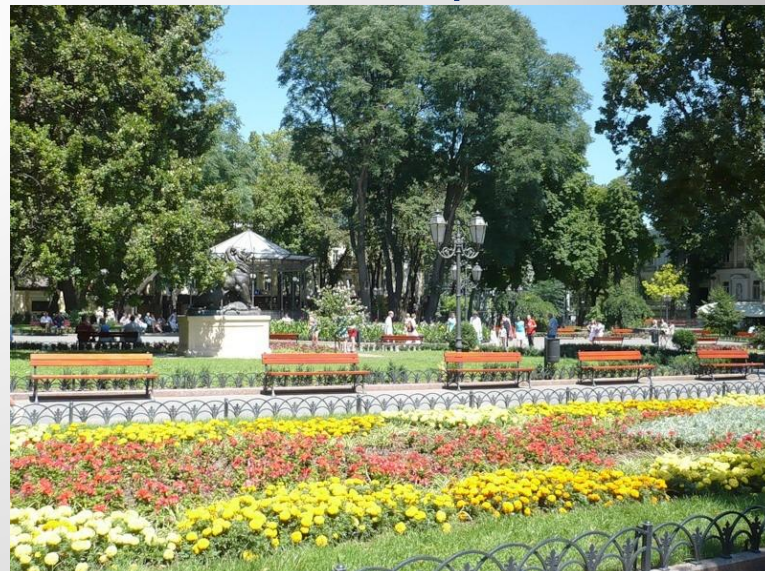

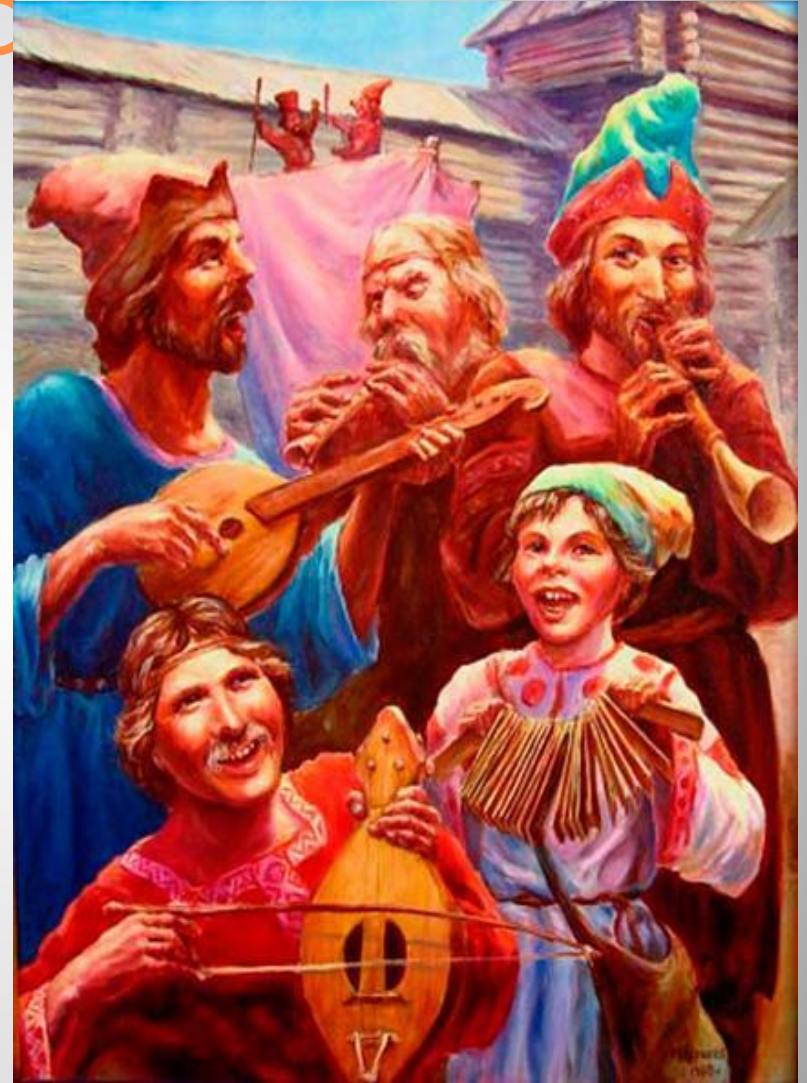
Holidays in Ukraine
